The strain should be: *aromA1248 riboA1 adG14 yA2*

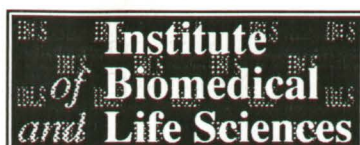
Plasmids will follow when I have sorted them out.
