Recent questions concerning the growth behavior of wild type strain number 79a FGSC #533 has prompted regrowth and retesting of this stock against other wild type strains.

It appears that this wild type stock has developed an unusual modifier which prevents growth and crossing from taking place at the normal rate and vigor. If a replacement is required, we suggest reordering stock FGSC $#988 \ \underline{74-OR8-1a}$ and/or $#987 \ \underline{74-OR23-1A}$. The origin of $\underline{79a}$ is described in Neurospora Newsletter 2:25 and, also, $\underline{74-OR8-1a}$ and $\underline{74-OR23-1A}$ in Neurospora Newsletter 8:25,26.

We would appreciate hearing from you if you have had difficulties with or noted any unusual behavior with FGSC #533 79a.

We trust your work has not been hampered too greatly because of the poor growth response of this particular strain.
