Dear Dr Ogata,

In a letter to Professor D.G. Catcheside (5 December 1967), you requested a stock of am-1 free of the morphological mutant present in FGS(#1191). I have now been able to separate them, and have forwarded am-1 cultures of both mating types under separate cover. I have also sent stocks of the morphological mutant, which I have labelled "CA1". It is an allele at the gulliver-1 locus, as judged by recombination with gul-1 (G). Also, gul-1(G) and gul-1 (CA1) have closely similar effects on the morphology of cot-1 (C102t) at 34°C.
