Dear Bill:

On deposit sheet FGSC # 2585, please delete
bottom line and "separable" from 2nd line up. I find that
acriflavine-resistance and 3-aminotriazole resistance are both found
in all ^{atr(RC3) and} acr-2 stocks tested*, ie. they show own resistance, and atr(RC3)
is just a recurrence of acr-2, selected with a different inhibitor.

atr(RC3) should thus be listed as acr-2 allele RC3. (FGSC 2207),
It is identical in phenotype with FGSC # 2585, and there is no need to
list them both. I have RC3 in a mating type, but see no point of
demonstrating it.

I see you don't have single-mutant strains of acr-2 (KH5), and
I'll send them in next time.
