I have checked the information in your letter of September 1, 1977 concerning strain CI8AG#6. The information is correct but requires one modification. CI8AG#6 was my designation for the entire strain (A, hist-2, ad-3A, ad-3B, nic-2, ad-2, aza-3, inos), not for only the $\frac{\text{aza-3}}{\text{aza-3}}$ allele. It seems to me that an appropriate allele number for the $\frac{\text{aza-3}}{\text{aza-3}}$ marker would be 006 because it was the sixth azaguanine-resistant mutant that I isolated.

You are correct in listing $\underline{aza-3}$ as being in Linkage Group III. I am sorry that I forgot to put in the Linkage Group when I filled out your form. If you have any further questions with respect to allele numbers, etc., please contact me.
