Dear Dr. Pridham:

Thank you for your January 23 letter in response to my inquiry regarding fungal cultures.

We are engaged in a study of Neurospora species, employing strains that have been collected by me or by others from various parts of the world. I do not desire to have laboratory-derived strains, but only strains derived from various substrates outside the lab, including any from ontjom in Java. I already have all those ARS strains that are also carried by the ATCC or by the Fungal Genetics Stock Center.

Since you do not have a published list, I have no way of knowing what number of Neurospora strains may be involved. I do not want to request an unreasonable number. However, if your collection contains up to 30 Neurospora strains that meet the above criteria, I would appreciate having them for study. We would need to know for each culture the place collection and preferably the date and substrate.
