Comments: On looking into old (1950) notebook it seems that 64-1 i had a different origin from the others - from the arginine/proline mutant 51506 T6 not ES041. It seems that both 51506 T6 and ES041 must have harbored i presumably (though not certainly) through common descent from a strain to which both had been crossed.
