Stu Brody just called. He agrees to calling
the cla strain T(1;VII) SB332 cla ; bd

(actually IL;VII R, since arms are known).

He detected and mapped the rearrangement.

I suggest, and he agrees, that the strain
be listed not just in the rearrangement section
of the stock list, but also in Part 1: single mutants
as cla, with cross reference to translocation section.

This is important because most users will be
interested in the ^{mutant} phenotype and not in the fact that
it is a translocation.
