
Dear Dr. Wilson:

Recently I forwarded six strains of Gelasinospora for deposit in your culture collection. In your reply (25.10.94) you asked me among other things if there were TRTC numbers for the four isolates from east Africa. In my reply (5.11.94) I indicated that we had used collection numbers and that was how the species were published. Upon reflection, considering that these are types, I felt that it would be appropriate to assign TRTC numbers. These are as given below with your assigned FGSC numbers included in parentheses for clarity.

Gelasinospora brevispora - TRTC 51743 (FGSC 7795)  
Gelasinospora cratophora - TRTC 51744 (FGSC 7796)  
Gelasinospora hapsidophora - TRTC 51745 (FGSC 7797)  
Gelasinospora dictyophora - TRTC 51746 (FGSC 7798)

I hope that this information will be helpful and I apologize for the delay in forwarding it to you.
