- (i) Here's something that will explain why it is useful to retain (and list) deposits of key strains from different sources: Not all may be the same, and only one or some may be authentic. Earliest thing is to leave them as they are. (The Em's, that is.) The Nemeyer (Perkin) Bury piece in FGR 34 was set up by Craig in a very awkward way, so that it was difficult to know what was text and what was figure legend. The enclosed copy rearranges it more logically -- by cut and paste. (By putting Tables and Figures at Top or bottom of a page, and separating legends and footnotes from text by lines, the distinction from text is made more readily.)
- (ii) It's difficult to advise re: the K. unum deposits without seeing the deposit sheets. I'll be glad to check them if you want to send on FAX. The enclosed papers should help. over
