Kevin:

I'm including col-18 stocks both with and without the helper. With slow growing mutants such as this, I've taken to carrying stocks in phenotypically wild-type heterokaryons, for ease of silica gelling and the convenience of being able to maintain frozen stocks and to use as ♀ in crosses.

Whether PGSC wants to keep slow growers, morphs, and other difficult to grow or inconvenient to transfer stocks in this way is a policy decision you and Judd may want to make. For example, you may find it desirable to make heterokaryons of the tns strains with the helper.
