Colleagues:

I find that col-6, till now listed as a point mutant in IV, is inseparable from a reciprocal translocation. The compendium entry on p. 50 should be changed accordingly, and col-6 should be deleted from the list of LG IV loci on page 218.

The mutant morphology is slow growing, small colonial, best kept as a heterokaryon with helper-1 (a m1 ad-3B cyh-1). Stocks are being sent to FGSC. It should be listed in Part VI A of the FGSC catalog, and merely cross referenced in the single-mutant list. The correct designation will be T(III;IV)S1302 col-6.
