Hi Kathy, et al.,

We can offer a kit-rate for these strains and materials. We usually do not offer a rate-cap on plasmids etc, but do want these materials to be widely distributed. Since we are also on the grant, we could do this in a couple of ways. We could offer these materials to the general community at a somewhat reduced rate, say \$100 for the 8 Neurospora strains, yeast strains and E. coli strain (plus shipping) To keep costs down, we could send these at no cost to people collaborating on the NIH grant.

We would also be happy to re-distribute the phosphinothricin to people collaborating on the NIH grant. I would not really want to get into 'selling' the antibiotic. If someone sends us the bulk herbicide, we could re-distribute it, asking only shipping costs.

I hope that these are reasonable limits.
