Hi

We have received our permit and I attach a copy for you to send with your strains.

It is best for us if you send the strains as a living culture. You can put 0.5 ml culture medium into a microfuge tube (or cryovial) and inoculate it with the strain you wish to deposit. Once it is clear that the strain is growing (after one or two days) please send the strains to me using FedEx. Please use the following address:

I will assign numbers as soon as the strains arrive.
