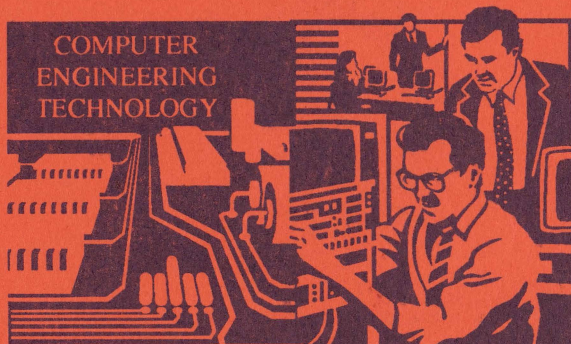

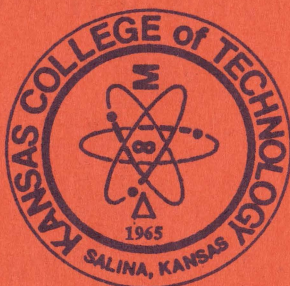
* Computer engineering technicians work closely with computer engineers, electrical engineers, and computer scientists to assist in the design and development of computers and computer based products. These technicians may be responsible for the design and programming of computerized manufacturing equipment, the construction of computer prototypes, installation of new computer systems including training and customer use, and the after-sale servicing of computers.

* The curriculum is 68 credit hours of courses concentrating on the electronics of the computer or computer systems. Graduates may choose to pursue a dual degree in Computer Engineering Technology and Electronic Engineering Technology. A dual degree can sharply improve employment prospects. The KCT program is accredited by the Technology Accreditation Commission of the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (TAC/ABET).

* Progressive advancements in the electronic and computer fields have created excellent job prospects for individuals with high-tech computer engineering technology experience. Computer engineering technicians may seek employment opportunities in computerized controls, medicine, manufacturing, aeronautics, law enforcement, national defense, and computer and electronics troubleshooting.
